Primary Energise	Increase daily opportunities for aerobic activity for all year groups, to improve gross and fine motor ability and combat childhood obesity	Primary Energise is a dance and movement programme that allows for short periods of activity at points in the day (morning break and lunch times) £60 + VAT Release time for staff	Primary Energise has been very popular with children and we have seen an increase in children choosing to participate in other physical activity.
Swimming	100% of LKS2 children can swim 25m by end of Y4	Swimming to be delivered to Y3 and Y4 (Y4 Autumn – Spring 1, Y3 Spring 2 – Summer) £5928.00	100% of children in mainstream classes can swim 25m.
Membership of London PE and School Sports Network (LPESN)	LPESN provide access to the school competition programme for Southwark, INSET training, PE Coordinator meetings and various events/workshops that improve children's activity levels and general physical literacy.
