Dear Parents and Carers

It is the time of year when we have new families joining us and it has been a pleasure to welcome them and see their children have such smooth and happy beginnings to their school lives in Reception. It has also been great to see so many older children return so keen to start school again in their new Year Groups, new classes and with their new teachers. The children look extremely smart and well turned out in their new uniforms and shiny shoes.

## **PE kit comprises:**

Plain white T shirt;

Plain black shorts with optional 'Brunswick' logo;

Plimsolls or trainers for outdoor sports and games.

At the beginning of the academic year your child will have a letter stipulating when they have PE and swimming

For swimming your child will need a towel, swimming costume/trunks (not shorts) and a swimming hat;

For outdoor PE, a tracksuit can be worn over PE kit in cold weather.
