Annual Reports and Pupil Books

Schools have a statutory duty to provide parents with a written report on their children's progress and attainment once a year. Even though most children have not attended school since 23 March, that duty remains, so your child will receive an End of Year Report on their progress and attainment for the Autumn and Spring Terms. Due to Covid-19 closing schools for most pupils in March, the children have not been able to take home their books and samples of work. We would like all pupils to have their books as they worked hard for two terms and they should be given the opportunity to look back and reflect on their progress and achievements.
