

Year 2 Autumn 1 Science- Living Things and Their Habitats

Key facts

1. All things are either living, dead or once lived.
2. A habitat describes where a living thing lives and micro-habitat is a smaller habitat for smaller living things.
3. All living things have suitable and unsuitable habitats based on their features and survival needs.
4. Food chains show the order that food is eaten and are made up of: producer, which produces its own food (plant), consumer which eats the producer (herbivore) and predator which eats the consumer (carnivore)
5. Herbivores eat only plants, carnivores eat only meat and omnivores eat a mixture of both.



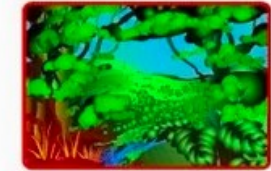
