Key facts

- Paul Cezanne was a French painter.
- He lived from 1839 to 1906
- Cezanne's often repetitive, exploratory brush strokes are highly characteristic and recognisable.
- Print making originated in China after paper was invented in AD 105
- Printmaking is an artistic process based on the transfer of an image from one surface to another
- Many fabrics and wallpapers are printed today
- Blending colours means creating an area between two colours where they gradually mix

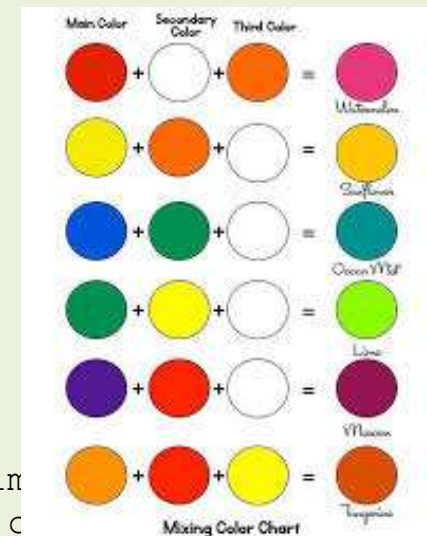
