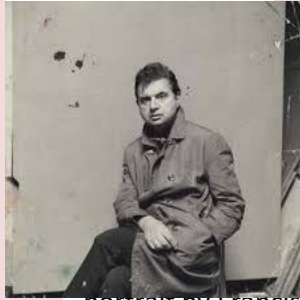


Year 2 Spring 2 Art – Digital Media: Expressive Portraits

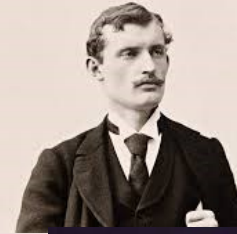
Key facts

- Edvard Munch was a Norwegian painter
- He lived from 1863 to 1944
- His most famous painting is 'Scream' and has become one of the most iconic paintings of the art world
- Francis Bacon was a British figurative painter
- He lived from 1909 to 1992
- Expressive portrait is another term for self-portrait. It is not about the expression on the face
- Colour and mark making are used expressively to move the portrait away from something that's a likeness of a person
