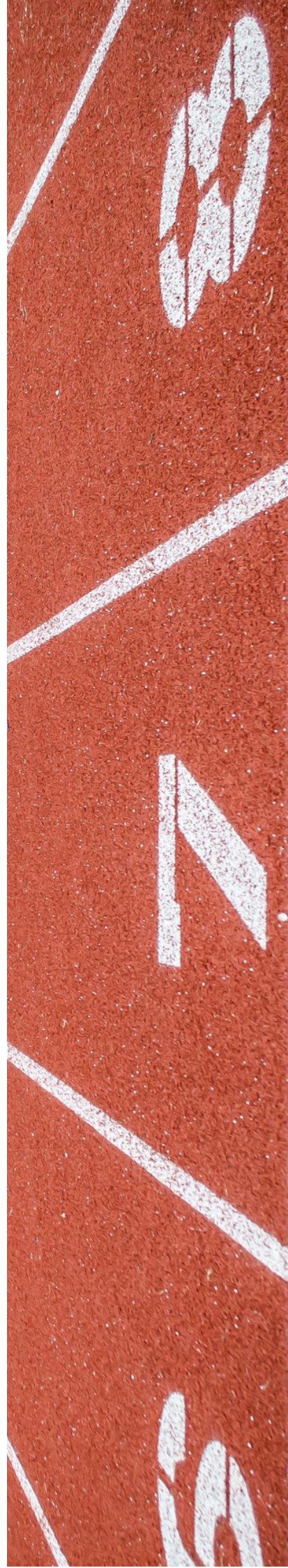


A message from Andrew Payne, our PE Lead:

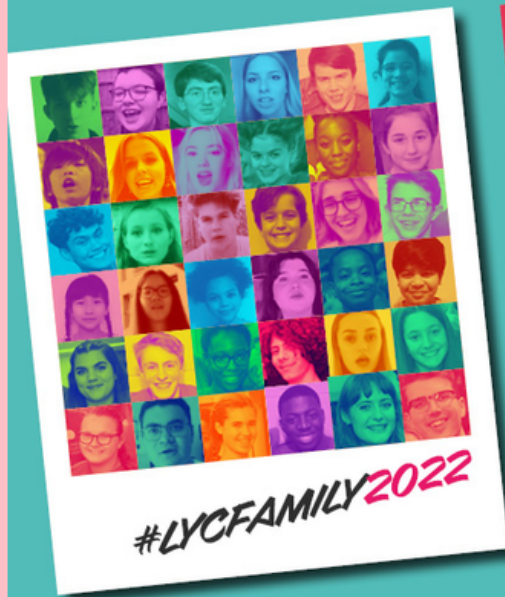

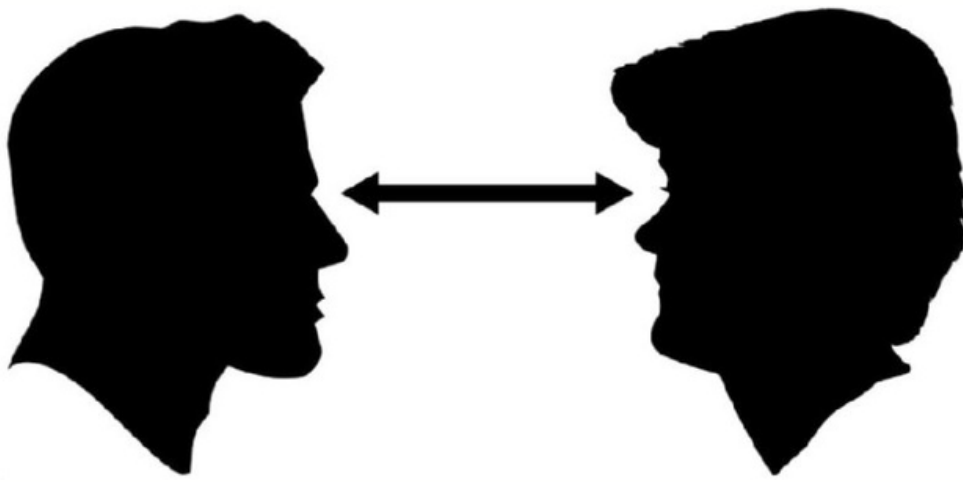
