Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to the last newsletter of this school year, which is jammed full of information about activities and clubs for children and families to enjoy during the Summer Break. For eligible families, Southwark is once again part of the city's Summer of Food and Fun initiative, which supports children to have a happy, healthy summer holiday. All details are below, along with many others that we hope will be of interest.

Thank you for completing the parents' and carers' survey. Your feedback is invaluable, and we will use it over the summer to inform improvements to our systems, including how and when we communicate with you. Thanks also to the BPPFA, that pulled off a cracking Summer Fair despite the weather (which the Fire Brigade made wetter still). Brunswick is delighted to have such committed volunteers who work so hard for its community, and we wish them well for their AGM today and in gaining charitable status. We are very grateful.

The time has come to say goodbye to three members of staff: Thomas Dowling, our music teacher who is beginning a new career in the North East, Absolum Akora, one of our HLTAs who is beginning a new career in community project management, and Susanna Renwick, our SENDCo who is moving to work at the Local Authority in West Sussex. I know you will wish them well, and I thank them for all they have done for the children and families of Brunswick Park.

I am extremely proud of all of Brunswick's children, who bring to the school such enthusiasm, curiosity and vitality. The school's outcomes this year are very strong, and at Key Stage 2 are significantly higher than the National Average (Brunswick = 77% of children achieving the Expected Standard in Reading, Writing and Maths vs a National Average of 59%). This is down to good teaching and all that goes with it, and good pupil attendance. Our Year 6 pupils attended school regularly, and I wish them, most of whom we have known for over 7 years, all the very best at their new schools. We will miss them very much, but know that many will pop back to say hello. We are always pleased to see them.

Finally, I wish you and your families all the very best for a peaceful and enjoyable summer break. I look forward to seeing you again in September, and to welcoming our new children in Nursery and Reception.

## Brunswick Park rocks at times tables!

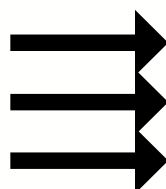
In the recent London Rocks competition, in which children from 307 London schools competed, Brunswick did *brilliantly*.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Uniform will be available to buy at the School Office every day during the first week of next term: 5-8 September.

**All children are expected to wear full school uniform daily, and the school PE kit on PE days (white T-shirt, black shorts/leggings/joggers, school jumper/cardigan, black trainers).**

Please do not send your child to school in non-uniform clothing.

# ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Pupil absence rates are still above pre-Covid levels, particularly in Key Stage 1. Improving attendance is a top priority for us, as children who attend school regularly make better progress and achieve better outcomes, which in turn affects their life chances.

We need to make sure as many children as possible are present from day one of next term and every school day thereafter.

Those first days back after a break really matter, as evidenced in a recent Children's Commissioner report (July 2022).

These are the levels of pupils attendance:

Excellent	98-100%
Good	95-97%
Requires Improvement	90-94%
Persistent Absence	Below 90%

Families with children who are persistently absent will be supported by the Local Authority's Family Early Help and Education Inclusion Teams to improve their children's school attendance from September, when our new Attendance Officer, Tracy Sherry, will work across the school to ensure as many children as possible attend school on time every day.

Lateness accounts for lost learning, and contributes to a child's level of attendance.

**Children need to:**

**Arrive at school by 08:50**

**Be seated in the classroom by 08:55**

**If children are not in their classrooms by 08:55 they are late.**

If your child is ill, the NHS had guidance for parents on whether or not they should be kept at home.

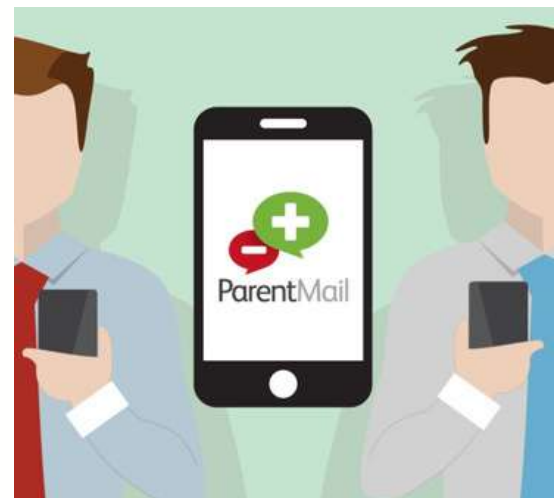
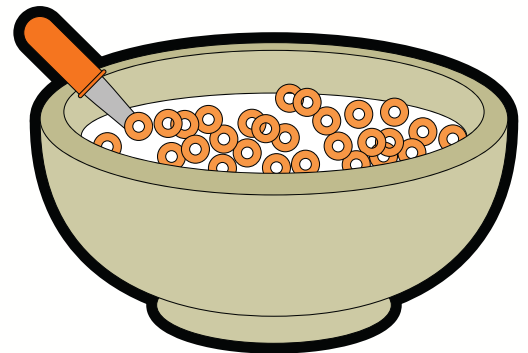
