

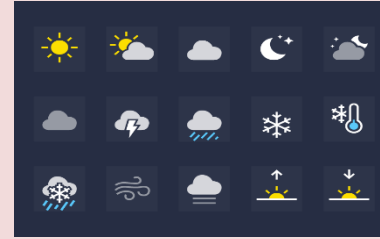
Year 1 Autumn 1 Science - Seasonal changes (Autumn and Winter)

Key Facts

1. In autumn, leaves start to change colour and fall off trees. Deciduous trees lose their leaves over winter.
2. In autumn, the weather can be rainy, windy and sometimes cloudy with a little sun, but not too warm. In winter, it is quite chilly and there can be rain, hail and snow.
3. Some animals are busy collecting food in autumn to store it, when getting ready for winter and some animals may fly to a warmer place.
4. Humans wear warmer clothes in autumn and winter, like jumpers, as it can be very windy.
5. The months of autumn are September, October and November. The months of winter are December, January and February.
