
- 1. Reptiles are cold-blooded, have scales and usually lay eggs.
- 2. Fish are similar to reptiles but also have fins and use gills to breathe under water.
- 3. Birds are warm blooded, lay eggs and have feathers and wings.
- 4. Amphibians can live on land and in water, but their skin stays wet, they are also cold-blooded and lay their eggs in water.
- 5. Mammals make milk, are warm blooded and have hair or fur; humans are part of this group.
- 6. Carnivores are animals that eat only meat, herbivores eat only plants, but omnivores eat both.
