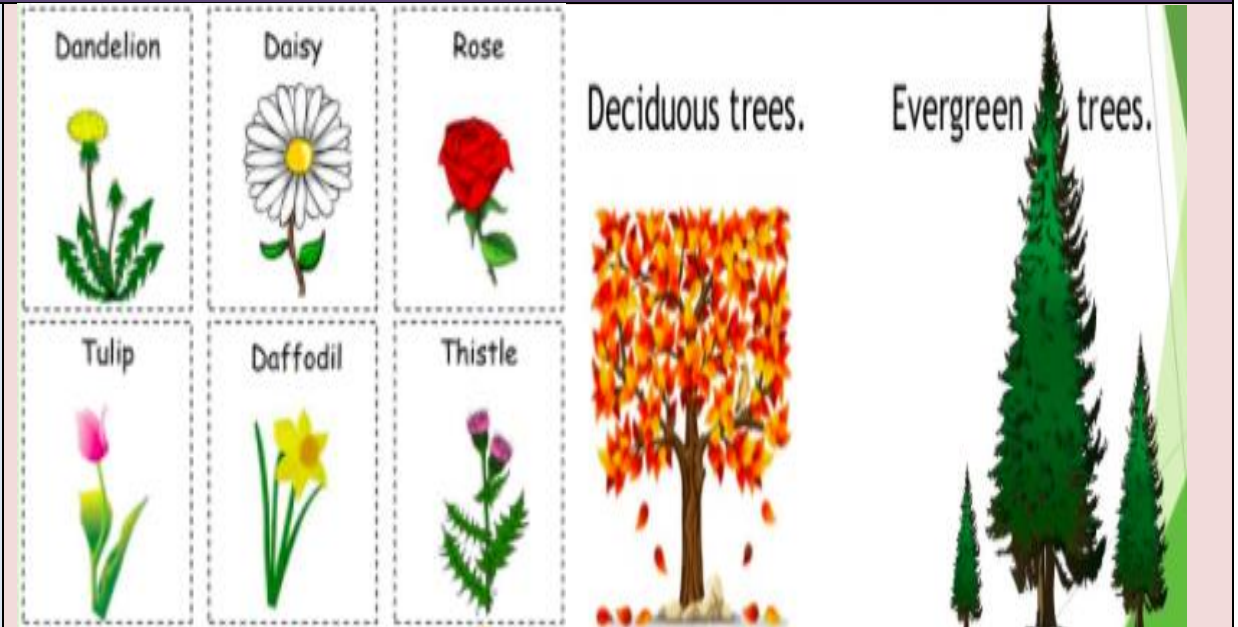


## Year 1 Summer 2 Science- Plants

### Key Facts

1. Spring is a time when flowers bloom and trees begin to grow.
2. Trees and bushes that lost their leaves over the winter begin to grow new leaves again and also flower in spring.
3. Animals become active in spring—waking up from winter sleep, migrating, breeding—because, with the warmth, plants grow and there is more food.
4. Wild plants grow independently whereas garden plants are planted by humans.
5. An evergreen tree has leaves all year round.
6. Deciduous trees shed their leaves in Autumn, through to Winter and then grow new leaves in the Spring.
