

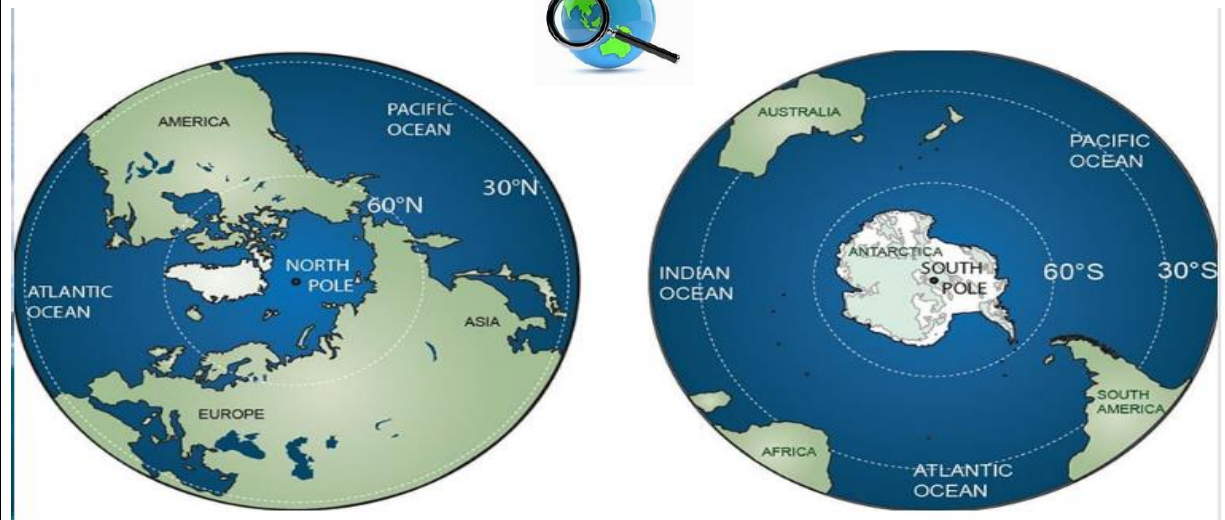
Year 4 Summer 1 Humanities – Antarctica - Physical and Human Geography

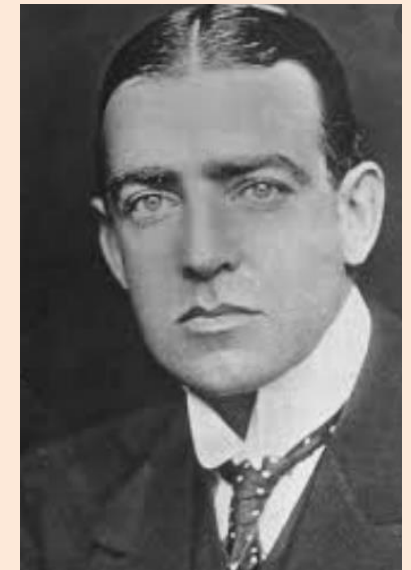
